Critical Learning Standards for Driver Education

Critical Learning Standard #1

The student will be able to apply the social, physical, mental and emotional skills that are necessary to successfully drive an automobile.

Critical Learning Standard #2

The student will be able to identify and understand the Illinois roadway signs, controls, and basic rules of the road.

Critical Learning Standard #3

The student will be able to understand proper control of the vehicle during all driving conditions (i.e.: adverse road and weather conditions, and mechanical conditions, etc.)

The student will be able to make responsible driving choices when controlling the vehicle (i.e.: No texting, Zero Tolerance, and changing driving laws).

The student will be able to successfully complete their pre-driving checks.

The student will be able to correctly perform the driving maneuvers that are required on the state of Illinois driving test.
