- You're applying for a Student Parking Permit tag to be used only during the **2nd Semester** of the 2017-2018 school year.
- You may fill out this application form if you are part of the **2018** or **2019** graduating class.
- The cost of the Student Parking Permit is **\$75.00**, you must have a valid driver's license and student I.D. to purchase the permit. Payment can be made by check payable to Schaumburg High School or cash, and is paid to the school cashier.
- The purchase dates for seniors and juniors buying a permit are: **December 18-December 22.**

Schaumburg High School Parking/Driving Rules

- The opportunity to purchase and utilize a parking permit on campus is a privilege not a right. A student's pass will be revoked for attendance and discipline reasons without a refund.
- Parents and school authorities have the right to revoke a student's parking privilege at any time. The parking tag will be confiscated and fees forfeited for that semester.
- The individual school is not liable for any damage, theft, injury or death that may occur as a result of a person driving to school or parking on school property.
- Student vehicles are subject to search by school officials when warranted.
- The student parking tag must be hung on the rear view mirror so that the number is visible from outside the vehicle. Student parking is restricted to parking spaces which **do not** have a white line across the entrance to the parking space. Staff parking is indicated by a white line across the entrance to the parking space.
- Students will lose parking privileges and be subject to school disciplinary action and/or citation if they:
 - drive in a careless or dangerous manner.
 - possess and/or use alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, weapons, and/or drugs in or about the vehicle.
 - use a vehicle to violate any school regulation, village ordinance, state law or federal law.
 - fail to report an accident or damage to another vehicle or property.
 - park in non-designated areas such as no parking zones, walkways, staff lots, aisles, over or outside of yellow lines, or visitor parking.
 - sell, copy, or allow someone to copy your parking permit.
 - possess or display a lost or stolen parking tag that is not registered to you.
 - park in the school parking lot without a permit.
 - loiter in vehicles or parking areas.
 - violate the academic or behavioral expectations of the Saxon Privilege Option Program.
- Changes to vehicle information registered with the parking permit must be reported. There will be no refund of the student parking user fee for the current semester. Students may purchase only one parking tag per semester.
- Parking tags are non-transferable and cannot be sold or given to another individual.
- Parking tags which are lost or stolen will not be replaced. Students should report lost or stolen tags to their administrator immediately.
- Students riding motorcycles to school must also have parking permission. Students should notify their administrator if they are riding a motorcycle to school.
