

Seal of Biliteracy Application 2017-2018

Township High School District 211 students have the opportunity to earn the Illinois State Seal of Biliteracy by demonstrating high levels of proficiency in English and an additional language. Students interested in taking the assessments for the Illinois State Seal of Biliteracy should complete this application and submit it to the Student Services Department by **February 23, 2018**. If your student earns the Seal of Biliteracy, the official Seal of Biliteracy will be available for pick up during the summer in the Student Services Department. In addition, students who earn the Illinois Seal of Biliteracy will have it indicated on their transcript. As of July 22, 2016, Illinois public universities will accept the State Seal of Biliteracy as equivalent to 2 years of foreign language coursework taken during high school if a student's high school transcript indicates that he or she received the State Seal of Biliteracy.

To earn the Illinois State Seal of Biliteracy you must demonstrate proficiency in English and an additional language. If you do not complete both the English and additional language assessments within the same school year, please note the criteria may change per the Illinois State Board of Education. Below is the criteria for the 2017-2018 Seal of Biliteracy.

English		Additional Language
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Earn an ACCESS composite score of at least 4.8 on ACCESS, OR Earn an ACT composite score of at least 21 on the ACT, OR Earn an Evidence Based Reading and Writing Section score of at least 480 on the SAT. 	AND	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Have earned a 4 or 5 in the Advanced Placement language exam - Spanish, Chinese (Traditional or Simplified), French, German, Italian, or Japanese, OR Earn a minimum score of I-5 on the ACTFL's Assessment of Performance toward Proficiency in Languages (AAPPL) exam. The following languages assessed with the AAPPL exam: Arabic, Chinese (Traditional or Simplified), French, German, Hindi, Italian, Korean, Portuguese, Russian, Spanish, and Thai, OR Earn Intermediate High on the STAMP exam. The following language assessed with the STAMP exam: Japanese and Polish.
