On April 10, 2018, all juniors will be administered the Illinois State Board of Education required assessment, the College Board Scholastic Achievement Test (SAT).

On the same date, sophomores will be administered the PSAT 10 to measure their progress in the areas of reading, writing, language and math. The PSAT 10 is used as an indicator of individual students' areas for academic growth prior to taking the State-required junior year assessment. 
Please note that testing ends at approximately 12:20 p.m. on April 10. Sophomore students will be dismissed from school at that time. Buses will be available for those who normally use bus service. Students who require test accommodations beyond 12:20 p.m. will have alternative transportation options.

Listed below are some ways you can assist your son or daughter in preparing for the tests.

1. Encourage your student to get plenty of sleep, especially the week of testing.
2. Encourage your son or daughter to eat a nutritious breakfast on the days of testing.
3. **Your sophomore should bring four number 2 pencils with good erasers and a calculator for use on certain parts of the test.**

Please encourage your student to put forth his or her best effort on this test in order to demonstrate his/her true capabilities.
